INFORMATION AND INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES

Anna University is inviting applications for admission to B.Arch. degree programmes for the seats reserved for Other State (OS) candidates in the School of Architecture & Planning (SAP), Guindy, Anna University, Chennai-25. The candidates can register & submit their application online through the Web Portal: cfa.annauniv.edu/cfa.

1. ALLOCATION OF SEATS

Two seats are reserved for Other State Candidates in B.Arch. degree programme (for all the regions put together).

3. ELIGIBILITY & MERIT LIST

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Based on the Gazette Notification and Circular of Council of Architecture, the following eligibility criteria for B.Arch. Degree Course shall be followed:

- No Candidate shall be admitted to architecture course unless she/he has passed 10 + 2 or equivalent examination with Physics and Mathematics as compulsory subjects along with either Chemistry or Biology or Technical Vocational Subject or Computer Science or Information Technology or Informatics Practices or Engineering Graphics or Business Studies with at least 45% marks in aggregate or passed 10+3 Diploma Examination with Mathematics as compulsory subject with at least 45% marks in aggregate.
- The candidate needs to qualify an aptitude test in Architecture “NATA” conducted

by the Council of Architecture (COA) or “JEE” conducted by National Testing Agency (NTA), New Delhi.

- The Qualifying Marks for the NATA 2025 would be based on the following Rules:
 1. A minimum of 20 marks must be secured in PART A
 2. A minimum of 20 marks must be secured in PART B
 3. Overall qualifying marks for NATA 2025 shall be 60 marks out of 200 as aggregate of Part A and Part B.
- A Candidate will not qualify in NATA-2025 unless all three conditions mentioned above are satisfied. In case the candidate appears in multiple tests, all the previous scores of NATA 2025 shall appear on the score card. The best score obtained in all attempts shall be taken as the valid score for NATA 2025.
- In case a candidate has obtained a valid score in NATA 2024 and appears for NATA 2025, his/her NATA 2025 score shall be calculated/determined as per COA instructions.

MERIT LIST

- The ranking of candidates for the seats will be on the basis of the marks obtained in the qualifying examination and also in the NATA2024/2025 conducted by Council of Architecture or JEE (Main) Paper2 B.Arch conducted by NTA.
- The academic marks of all subjects of the candidate (Tamilnadu H.Sc /CBSE/ICSE/equivalent) shall be reduced to 200 or Diploma marks in all the semesters put together shall be reduced to 200. The Ranking of the candidates shall be based on the total marks of 400 (NATA/JEE mark out of 200 and academic mark out of 200). A merit list shall be prepared based on the total marks of 400. In cases where more than one candidateIn cases where more than one candidate have got the same marks in the common merit list, the inter-se-merit among such candidates shall be determined in the order of priority as specified below : (i) Higher Secondary/Diploma Aggregate (ii) date of birth (elder will be given preference) and (iii) Random number Assigned (higher value will be given preference)

- If the candidate has grade certificates, he/she has to produce either the actual marks or equivalent marks for the respective grades. In case equivalent mark range is given for grades by the respective examination authorities, only the minimum marks applicable to the grades in the subjects will be taken into account. The candidate should submit equivalent mark or mark range for grades from the respective board only.
- **Letters from Principals regarding equivalent mark or mark range for grades will not be accepted.** The candidate has to provide a pass certificate, if it is not clear from the mark sheet whether the candidate has passed all the subjects. Mark sheets with voluminous data or confusing formats will not be accepted. The decision of Anna University will be final in case of any ambiguity in the eligibility criteria.

Note:

1. For the purpose of calculation of marks for eligibility in respect of sandwich Diploma candidates, the marks of all the other semesters in which there is no industrial training shall be considered.

2. For minimum eligibility, rounding of marks and normalized marks will not be considered.

3.Improvement Marks: As per the G.O. No. 184 HE (J2) Dept. dt: 09.06.2005 and G.O. (st) No. 143 HE (J2) Dept. dt: 06.05.2008 improvement marks obtained by the candidates including Other State candidates from 2006 onwards will not be considered.

4. PROCEDURE FOR REGISTRATION OF APPLICATION

1. Candidate should apply only through Online in the Web Portal cfa.annauniv.edu/cfa/.
2. The candidate should use a valid and functional e-mail id and a valid and functional mobile number for registration of online application. This email id and mobile number must be maintained active, as all the communications to the candidates will be sent only to the registered e-mail id and mobile number.
3. **An application without any one of the relevant certificate or mark sheet will be rejected. An online application uploaded without photograph will be rejected.**

4. MODE OF PAYMENT

The Candidate should pay the Registration fee as detailed below only through Online Payment (only through Credit Card / Debit Card).

5. *The candidate need not send the printout of the online application or any other documents to the University.*
6. The applications received directly other than the online application portal will not be considered and will be rejected.

5. DOCUMENTS TO BE UPLOADED

- (1) Recently taken photograph
 - (2) Mark sheet of HSC or Equivalent Examination (XI and XII)
 - (3) Mark Sheet of X Standard
 - (4) Transfer Certificate / Migration Certificate
 - (5) Permanent Residence Certificate (as in **Certificate I**)
 - (6) NATA /JEE mark sheet and Hall Ticket
- ❖ Candidates should ensure that correct marks are furnished by him/her in his/her application. If it is found that the marks furnished by him/her in the application are not correct, then he/she will forfeit the admission at any stage of study.
 - ❖ **The candidates are informed that admission given at the time of counseling will only be Provisional. In accordance with rules prescribed for admission, if they are found ineligible on verification of original certificates / particulars by the Dean / University, they cannot claim any right for admission or continuation of study at any stage.**

Further, the confirmation of Admission is subject to verification of marks / Certificates by the Authorities. If the mark sheet is found to be not a genuine one, admission is liable for cancellation at any stage of study.

6. COUNSELING

- The overall rank and community-wise rank lists will be published in Anna University, Chennai website cfa.annauniv.edu/cfa . Details will not be published in Newspapers.
- The Counseling for Admission for the Academic year 2025-26 will be conducted only through Online mode. The Web Portal for exercising the choice of the branch of study will be enabled after the publication of Merit List.
- Selection of the college and the Programme is the sole responsibility of the candidate.
- Prior to a Candidate exercising his/her choice, an initial amount of Rs. 5,000/- should be paid through Online mode and also a Non-Refundable Counseling fee of Rs.300/- (+18% GST) for General Category and SC/ST Category. Once a seat is allotted to the candidate, Rs.5,000/- already paid will be adjusted towards the Tuition fee.
- Allotted candidates will be permitted to download the Provisional Allotment and also the receipt for ₹5000/- from the Web Portal. The Balance Tuition fee should be paid in the college during Admission.

An applicant who declines after the publication of Tentative Allotment OR an applicant who is not allotted a Branch during Provisional Allotment shall be eligible for 100% Refund of the Initial Deposit. After provisional allotment, an applicant who does not join the branch allotted shall be eligible for 80% of Refund of the initial deposit. The candidates eligible for refund should apply through the Web Portal (cfa.annauniv.edu/cfa) within six months from the date of counseling. The application for refund submitted beyond six months will not be considered.

1. The Original Certificate should be signed by the Officer of the Revenue Department not below the rank of a Tahsildar in the District concerned or by the Block Development Officer–Cum–Panchayat Union Commissioner in the Block concerned.
2. The certificates should bear the stamp of the office of the Officer signing the certificate. The certifying officer should insist upon clear proof of the permanent residence of the parent or guardian of the candidate and satisfy himself of the genuineness of the residential qualification.
3. The State of Permanent Residence of a candidate's guardian will be taken into account only if both the parents of the candidate are dead. The relationship of the guardian to the candidate should also be mentioned. If both the parents are alive, only the State of Permanent Residence of father should be taken into account.
